CIRCULATION OF RTSM STATISTICAL BOOKLET (DEC 2018-MAY 2019)

Reference to the subject stated above, it is to state that the Secondary Education Department, through its Performance Management Cell (PMC), has prepared a statistical booklet on the findings of school monitoring visits to 10,971 schools across all districts of Balochistan from Dec 2018 to May 2019 hereby forwarded to you for its effective utilization to ensure efficient resource management and service delivery at school level. The data in report must be used for identification of priority areas in districts informed by evidence provided by the report and determine priorities for your respective districts.

- The report covers key priority areas for the education department. It states that 73.8% schools in Balochistan were monitored during the period covered of which 27.4% schools were closed on the day of visit. Moreover, teacher and student attendance percentages were reported to be 75.4% and 76.2% respectively. The situation of useable infrastructure is good with 85.8% rooms reported as fit-foruse, whereas the functional status of available toilets is alarmingly low with only 50.7% of available toilets reported as functional. Similarly, only 18.8% schools provide access to clean drinking water. Performance on provision of furniture for teachers and desks and mats for students is reported to be at 68.1% schools in terms of teachers and 63.6% for students. Finally, the report provides that only 48.1% schools have been visited by education department officials within the last three months.
- Additionally, the Secondary Education Department acknowledges and appreciates the role 3. of Real Time School Monitoring teams who conducted 17,618 monitoring visits to 10,971 schools from December 2018 to May 2019 to provide the data used in this statistical booklet. The department also appreciates Director of Education (school), Divisional Directors, District Education Officers (DEOs) and their staff for their continuous support to RTSM teams and playing an effective role in the school monitoring process.
